Calfbook Bulls.

*We were very strict in the selection of young bulls. You have raised your
standards well by culling any animal scoring 6 or less. You will see favourable
results in the near future.*

Calfbook Females .

*The average quality of your young replacement heifers was most pleasing. It
Indicates very carefully considered and goal orientated matings.
There is still much room for improvement, the heifers scoring 5 or 6 show
That there are still a number of cows not producing above average calves.*

Herd Sires

*You have one of the best herd sire bull batteries in the Simbra breed.
Most of the bulls are proven too..
If a good medium to small framed, broad, muscular, long red bull becomes available
you need to act.
Pedigree should also play a bigger role in your selection than your current emphasis
on EBV's. We need a bull with prepotency (erfdwang), producing red, beefy bulls,
and heifers.*
